Supplies Needed

- Black Block Printing Ink
- Magenta Block Printing Ink
- Turquoise Block Printing Ink
- Yellow Block Printing Ink
- 4x6" Linoleum Blocks
- Block Printing Paper
- Mixing Trays
- Brayers
- Scissors (optional)



Four-Color Monoprint Project Kit

Web Project 100

50-Project Set—Includes 25 sheets of 9x12" mulberry printmaking paper, four Red Baron mounted linoleum blocks measuring 4x6" each, four hard rubber brayers measuring 4" wide, one each of black, magenta, turquoise and yellow 5 oz. Handy Art block ink tubes and step-by-step instruction sheet. Ink is AP Seal, non-toxic.

Step 1

You will need one brayer, one mixing tray and one linoleum block for each color. Roll one color of block printing ink evenly onto a brayer. Using the inked brayer, cover one entire 4x6" linoleum block with ink.



Step 2

Tear or cut out a 6x8" sheet of block print paper. Place the inked block on top of the paper.

Step 3

Holding the sides of the block, flip the block over with the paper still attached. Draw on the paper using your finger, a blunt modeling tool or the handle end of a paint brush.



Step 4

Repeat steps 1-3 with each additional color. Ensure accurate color registration by aligning the inked block on the paper, pressing down lightly and flipping it over to print additional colors.
