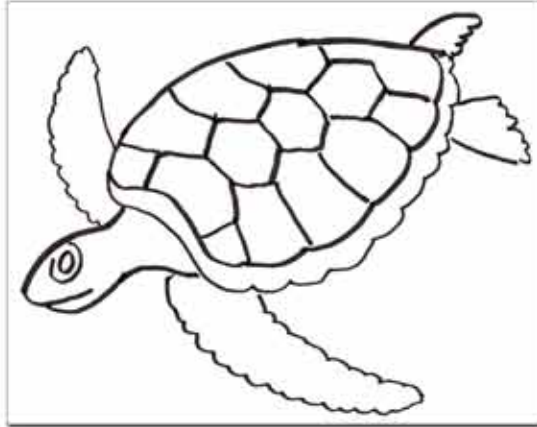


Simple Fabric Fun Batik

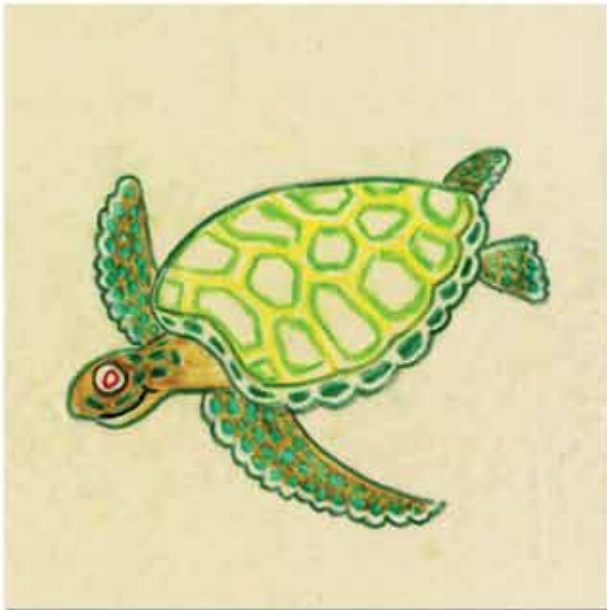
Supplies Needed

- Muslin
- Pentel Arts Fabric Fun Pastel Dye Sticks
- Newsprint
- Fabric Dye
- White Paper
- Dark Marker
- Scissors
- Household Iron
- Disposable Gloves



Step 1

Use a dark colored marker to draw your image on a white piece of 8-1/2 x 11" or 9x12" paper.



Step 2

Cut a 12" square of muslin. Place your image behind the muslin and trace with desired colors of Fabric Fun Pastel Dye Sticks. Place a piece of newsprint on top of the muslin and iron to heat-set the pastels.



Step 3

Dye muslin according to package directions. The image drawn with the Dye Sticks will act as a resist.

24-Project Set—Teach how to batik! Enough supplies to make up to 24 Simple Fabric Fun Batik projects! Simply draw on the muslin with dye sticks, heat set with an iron and then dye the fabric. The dye sticks will act as a resist. Complete kit includes a 100-sheet pad of 12x18" Richeson newsprint paper, 3 yards of 45" wide unbleached muslin, 12 sets of Pentel Art Fabric Fun pastel dye sticks (15 colors in each set), two packages of navy blue Rit dye and an instruction sheet. You will also need white paper, dark colored marker, scissors, household iron and disposable gloves. Fabric Fun dye sticks are AP Seal, non-toxic.
