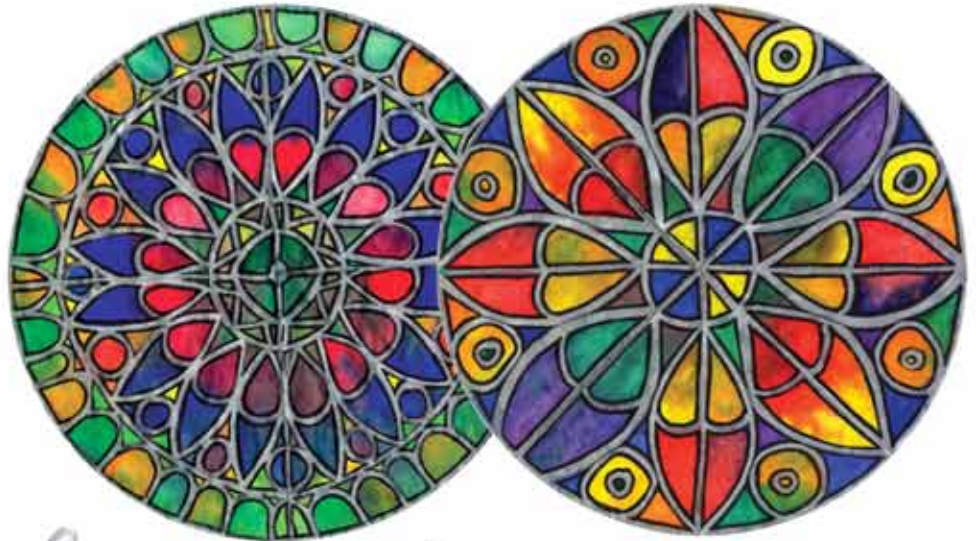


Color Diffusing Rose Window

Supplies Needed

- Color Diffusing Circles
- Water-Based Markers
- Silver Sharpie Marker
- Black Sharpie Marker
- Paint Brush
- Water Bowl



Step 1

Fold the color diffusing circle into quarters and use a Metallic Sharpie Marker to draw a design on the first quarter.



Step 3

Repeat tracing on next two sections until the entire circle is finished and has a symmetrical design covering the entire sheet.



Step 2

Unfold once, so that half of the paper is showing. Flip the half circle over and trace the other side of the design where it has bled through the paper.



Step 4

Outline the Metallic Sharpie Marker with Black Sharpie Marker to highlight the Metallic Sharpie and give it a shadowy look.



Step 5

Fold the circle into quarters again. On the top layer, fill in the white spaces with watercolor markers; this example uses Prang Classic Markers.

Step 6

Use a stiff paint brush to saturate the watercolor marker areas with water. Keep saturating the marker until it bleeds through all four layers of the diffusing paper.



Step 7

Unfold the color diffusing paper and allow design to dry.

100-Project Set—Enough supplies for 36 students at a time to make up to 100 rose window projects. Includes one 100-sheet package of Roylco 9" color diffusing circles, one 48-count tub of Prang classic markers, one 36-count tub of Sharpie silver permanent markers, 36 Sharpie black permanent markers and instructions. You will also need your own paint brushes and water bowls to complete this project. Prang and Sharpie markers are AP Seal, non-toxic.
