- Neon Acrylic Paints
- Paper Artstraws
- Paint Brush
- Scissors
- Glue

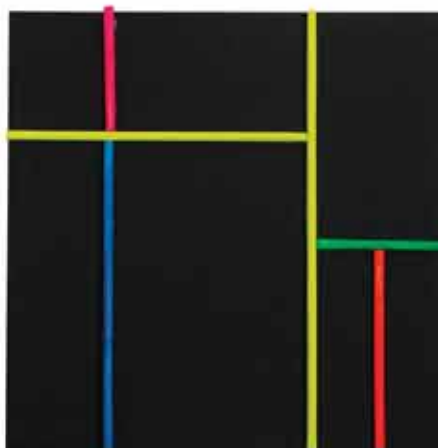
60-Project Set—Enough supplies for at least 60 students to each make a Neon Linear Paper Straw Sculpture. Includes ten 6-count packages of 8" square black Fredrix Cut Edge canvas panels (60 panels total), one pint each of blue, green, orange, pink, violet and yellow Chromacryl Students' neon acrylic, plus one 1800-count box of white Artstraws and an instruction sheet. You will also need paint brushes, scissors and glue. Chromacryl Students' neon acrylic is AP Seal, non-toxic.

Step 1

Using Chromacryl Students' Neon Acrylic, paint 18 straws; 3 each of all 6 colors. Some colors may require more than one coat.



Step 2

Once paint is dry, cut straws to different lengths and glue the first layer of your design on to an 8" square Fredrix Cut Edge Canvas Panel. Using a high quality glue like Aleene's Tacky Glue will help.



Step 3

Glue more straws on top of the first layer.



Step 4

Continue adding more layers as desired to finish the 3D sculpture.
